Dear Readers,

I am proud to be the head of one of the most technologically advanced mints worldwide, a mint which has based its activity on innovation and modern design. The confirmation of the achievements of the Mint of Poland in those areas are the number of international awards and distinctions. In the year 2010, two awards deserve particular attention.

The first of these I had the honor to receive myself at the 26th Mint Directors' Conference in Australia where the directors of competitive mints granted the Mint of Poland an award for combining glass and silver in what was found to be "the most technically advanced silver collector coin." The coin was struck for the National Bank of Poland ("the 400th Anniversary of Polish Settlement in North America"). Another important award was won in Italy. The jury of the Vicenza Numismatica 2010 numismatic competition awarded the Mint of Poland for the "Christening" coin struck for the National Bank of the Republic of Belarus. In Italy the coin was the absolute favorite of the competition in the "International Prizes" category. The jury emphasized that the Mint of Poland had managed to combine a poetic representation of the rite of baptism with the tradition of Slav families in what proved to be the most beautiful coin in the world.

Dear Readers, the collection of awards won by the Mint of Poland is expanded each year. This clearly shows that the company which I have the pleasure to be the director of is constantly developing and starting new trends in mint design and technology. Awards are extremely important, but what we value most is the recognition we enjoy among the collectors. I am extremely happy to know that the coins struck by the Mint of Poland are part of coin collections in every part of the world. Our success would be impossible to achieve if it were not for a long-standing cooperation with the National Bank of Poland which we are extremely proud of and which motivates us to further technological development and search for new ideas for coins.

In 2011, we would like to propose new series of collector coins, e.g. a series dedicated to the Silk Route or the Great Explorers as well as continue the series started in previous years such as the Famous Love Stories, Imperial Fabergé Eggs or Oddities of Nature series. I hope the upcoming year will bring new awards to the Mint of Poland cabinet of achievements. I am convinced that the talents of our medal-making artists, the experience of the Mint of Poland minters and the modern technologies that we use allow us to compete for the recognition of collectors from every corner of the world.

Dear Readers, the coins struck by the Mint of Poland are small works of art. I encourage you to start a collection of our coins. There is nothing more enjoyable than the contemplation of beauty created with all due care by people who have left a part of their heart in their work.

The "Coronation Egg" coin, the first coin of the gold edition of the series was, struck in a limited mintage – 222 pieces. Imperial Fabergé Eggs, also known as Tsar's Fabergé Eggs, are considered masterpieces of the jeweler's art and a symbol of extravagance and luxury. Created by Peter Carl Fabergé and his assistants for tsars: Alexander III and Nicholas II of Russia, the eggs were made of gold and silver and decorated with precious stones.

The "Amber Route" is a very popular series of beautiful collector coins. The characteristic feature of this series is an amber insert. The coins pay tribute to the main cities which lay along this ancient route of commercial contacts. The route connected the European states at the Mediterranean Sea and the lands on the southern shore of the Baltic Sea, and was named after the major object of travelers' desire, amber.

The exact route was never explicitly established, however, it is assumed that it went through Kaliningrad, Gdańsk, Wrocław, Elbląg, Stare Hradisko, Szombathely, Carnuntum and Aquileia.
